

**Participation in Actions for Europe Day "The Europe we live in –
The Europe we want", Patra 12 May 2018**



Hundreds of students flooded Patras Square on Saturday, May 12, 2018, at the event organized by the Region of Western Greece in the context of the Day of Europe celebrated on May 9, entitled "**The Europe We Live in - we want**". More than 470 pupils with 57 teachers were found at the open event, aimed mainly at young people, with the aim of encouraging and becoming active citizens of their country as well as of Europe.
